


BUSINESS OWNERS LOOK TO SENATOR DAINES FOR SUPPORT

FOREST SERVICE CONTINUES STUDY

Many of you remember the success of the business coalition on November 21, 2016, when a two-year time-out on mining began on our public lands north of Yellowstone.

That announcement began an evaluation by the U.S. Forest Service to determine whether to make these public lands off limits to mining for up to 20 years. The Forest Service continues their review, and we appreciate that they are seeking public input.
